Summary investment objective

To achieve a combination of income and growth by investing mostly in shares of smaller companies based, or carrying out much of their business, in emerging market countries. These are typically countries that are still developing their economies. Smaller companies are those valued at under US\$5 billion at the initial time of investment.
