INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Fund will aim to deliver a high real income stream over the target period and to wind-up or be repurposed at the end of the target period.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The Fund will aim to deliver real income for investors with an investment time horizon until 2040. In order to achieve this objective, the fund will apart from assets in liquid form, invest primarily in inflation-linked bonds with target maturity dates between 2035-2040, money market instruments and NCDs.



FUND COMMENTARY

As widely expected, the SARB cut the repo rate by 25bp in September, to 8%. It was a low risk move, given the sharp decline in core inflation since February, the relative rand stability since the election, South Africa's pedestrian economic growth and the Fed announcing a 50bp cut the day before. This was the first cut since July 2020 and follows seven consecutive meetings where it kept the rate at 8.25%.

The SA 10-year bond yield has now dropped more than 200bp since April. Directionally, it has tracked the 10-year US Treasury closely over the past year, indicative that the falling yield is not just about local improvements. Still, the spread between the two (5.06% at month end) – signalling a narrowing of SA's risk premium - is at its lowest in almost ten years.



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General Information

Total Expense Ratio (TER)

The Fund's **Total Expense Ratio (TER)** reflects the percentage of the average **Net Asset Value (NAV)** of the portfolio that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the portfolio. A higher TER does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. The current TER cannot be regarded as an indication of future TER's. During the phase in period TER's do not include information gathered over a full year.

Transaction Costs (TC)

Transaction Costs (TC) is the percentage of the value of the Fund incurred as costs relating to the buying and selling of the Fund's underlying assets. Transaction costs are a necessary cost in administering the Fund and impacts Fund returns. It should not be considered in isolation as returns may be impacted by many other factors over time including market returns, the type of Fund, investment decisions of the investment manager and the TER.

Total Investment Charge (TIC)

The sum of the TER and TC. The accurate figures will be available a year after the fund's inception date.

Glossary Summary

Performance: Performance has been calculated using NAV to NAV with income reinvested.

Moderately Conservative: This portfolio can invest across the duration spectrum from money market to long bonds, which can result in capital volatility over the shorter term and deviation from the benchmark

Fund Specific Risk

Default Risk: The risk that the issuers of fixed income instruments may not be able to meet interest payments nor repay the money they have borrowed. The issuers credit quality is vital. The worse the credit quality, the greater the risk of default and therefore investment loss.
