The Lodestar Global Core Equity Fund will aim to provide medium to long-term capital growth. The Fund will seek to deliver long-term out performance as well as volatility that does not exceed that of the market over time. In order to achieve this objective, the fund will invest in selected shares across a selection of developed market large cap shares.

The fund will seek to capture the broad market risk premium on equity selection opportunities. The portfolio will invest in Developed Market shares. The portfolio is only permitted to invest in listed financial instruments in line with its investment mandate.

Fund Commentary

The portfolio was implemented in October 2024 and the performance commentary is for 1 November to 31 December 2024.

The Lodestar Global Core Equity Fund is a rules-based portfolio that is implemented and managed in a systematic manner. The investment process is followed objectively and the portfolio manager makes no subjective decisions.

The fund invests exclusively in large Developed Markets. The top three regional exposures at the end of December 2024 were the United States (77%), the Eurozone (7%) and Japan (4%).

Over the period the fund underperformed its benchmark due to large and concentrated moves in Mega Cap stocks post the US election. The three largest contributors to portfolio performance (in US\$) were Broadcom (NASDAQ:AVGO) +0.60%, Tesla (NASDAQ:TSLA) +0.43% and Walmart (NYSE:WMT) +0.29%. The three largest detractors from portfolio performance (in US\$) were American Tower REIT Corp (NYSE:AMT) -0.17%, BHP Group Ltd (ASX:BHP) -0.16% and Abbvie Inc (NYSE:ABBV) -0.15%.

The aim of the fund is to use Large Cap equities to provide diversified, broad market exposure. The fund never holds large concentrated positions. We believe that this strategy, which maintains a focus on risk management and is agnostic to benchmark weights, provides superior long-term, risk adjusted returns. Given the nature of the market rally at the end of 2024, the size of the underperformance is within expectations. The portfolio remains fully invested and aligned with the Lodestar systematic rules-based investment process and agnostic to any subjective views of the market by the investment team.

The portfolio has adhered to its policy objective.

There were no changes to the portfolio post the initial implementation in October 2024.

Glossary

Annualised performance: Annualised performance shows longer term performance rescaled to a 1 year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

Highest & Lowest performance: The highest and lowest performance for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown. NAV: The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.

Current Yield: Annual income (interest or dividends) divided by the current price of the security

CPU: Cents Per Unit to the Glossary

Alpha: Denotes the outperformance of the fund over the benchmark.

Sharpe Ratio: The Sharpe ratio is used to indicate the excess return the portfolio delivers over the risk free rate per unit of risk adopted by the fund. Standard Deviation: The deviation of the return stream relative to its own average.

Max Drawdown: The maximum peak to trough loss suffered by the Fund since inception.

Dividend Yield: The weighted average dividend yield of all the underlying equity in the Fund. The dividend yield of each company is the dividends per share divided by the price.

PE Ratio: The weighted average price earnings ratio of all the underlying equity in the Fund. The price earnings ratio of each company is the price divided by the earnings per share.
