
Investment Objective

The Laurium SA Flexible Prescient Fund has a primary investment objective of long-term capital growth. The fund aims to achieve a return of at least 5% above CPI per annum, measured over rolling 3 year periods.

Investment Strategy

The fund invests in a diversified range of local asset classes. These asset classes include a flexible combination of investments in the equity, fixed interest, bond, money and property markets. The fund uses fundamental bottom-up research, with a value bias, to generate a concentrated but conservative portfolio.



Total Expense Ratio

The Fund's Total Expense Ratio (TER) reflects the percentage of the average Net Asset Value (NAV) of the portfolio that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the portfolio. Conservative: Generally low risk portfolios have minimal equity exposure or no equity exposure, resulting in far less volatility than a more aggressive mandated portfolio and in turn the probability of capital loss (permanent/temporary) is less likely. However, expected potential long term investment returns could be lower over the medium to long term

Moderate | Moderate-Aggressive: These portfolios generally hold more equity exposure than low risk portfolios but less than high risk portfolios. In turn the expected volatility is higher than low risk portfolios, but less than high risk portfolios. The probability of losses are higher than that of the low risk portfolios, but less than high risk portfolios. Expected potential long term investment returns could therefore be lower than high risk portfolios due to lower equity exposure, but higher than low risk portfolios.
