The Fund will select ethical (socially responsible) companies based on analysis of which are most likely to benefit from our themes, and are well placed to grow their revenues and cash flows as a result of them. The Fund will choose global themes which track long-term worldwide growth trends (rather than those relevant only to particular regions or markets).

The Fund will avoid companies that are materially engaged in certain sectors, including the production or distribution of tobacco, alcohol, armaments, gambling, adult entertainment and the extraction of fossil fuels.
